PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Groups are very welcome in Quilpie Shire. Make your first stop the Quilpie Visitor Information Centre, Museum and Gallery, located in the main street of town. The interactive museum displays the rugged history of the early pioneers, and the Shire Gallery hosts an exhibition each month including travelling displays and works by local artists. The Military History and Railway Museum adjoin the centre and are definitely worth a visit. The centre offers a local hop-on guide service for visiting coach groups. Tours range from 1.5 to 2 hours and can include morning/afternoon teas or lunch options.

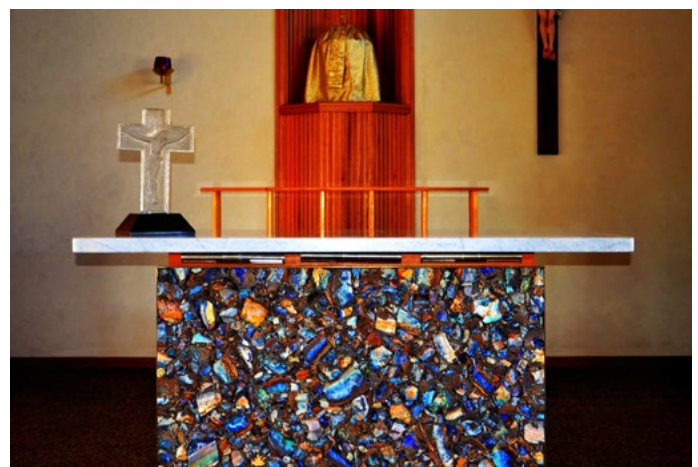

TOWN TOUR HOP-ON GUIDE SERVICE

Discover the history and unique landscapes of Quilpie town and surrounds. Our local guide will board your coach at the Visitor Information and will offer historic and interesting commentary about the Quilpie Shire on a town tour. This tour may visit Baldy Top Lookout, the Opal Fossicking area; St Finbarrs' Opal Altar, Quilpie Airport mini museum; the Powerhouse Museum and more. The tour may include either morning/afternoon at The Lake (nearby cattle station) or lunch at the Quilpie Heritage Inn.

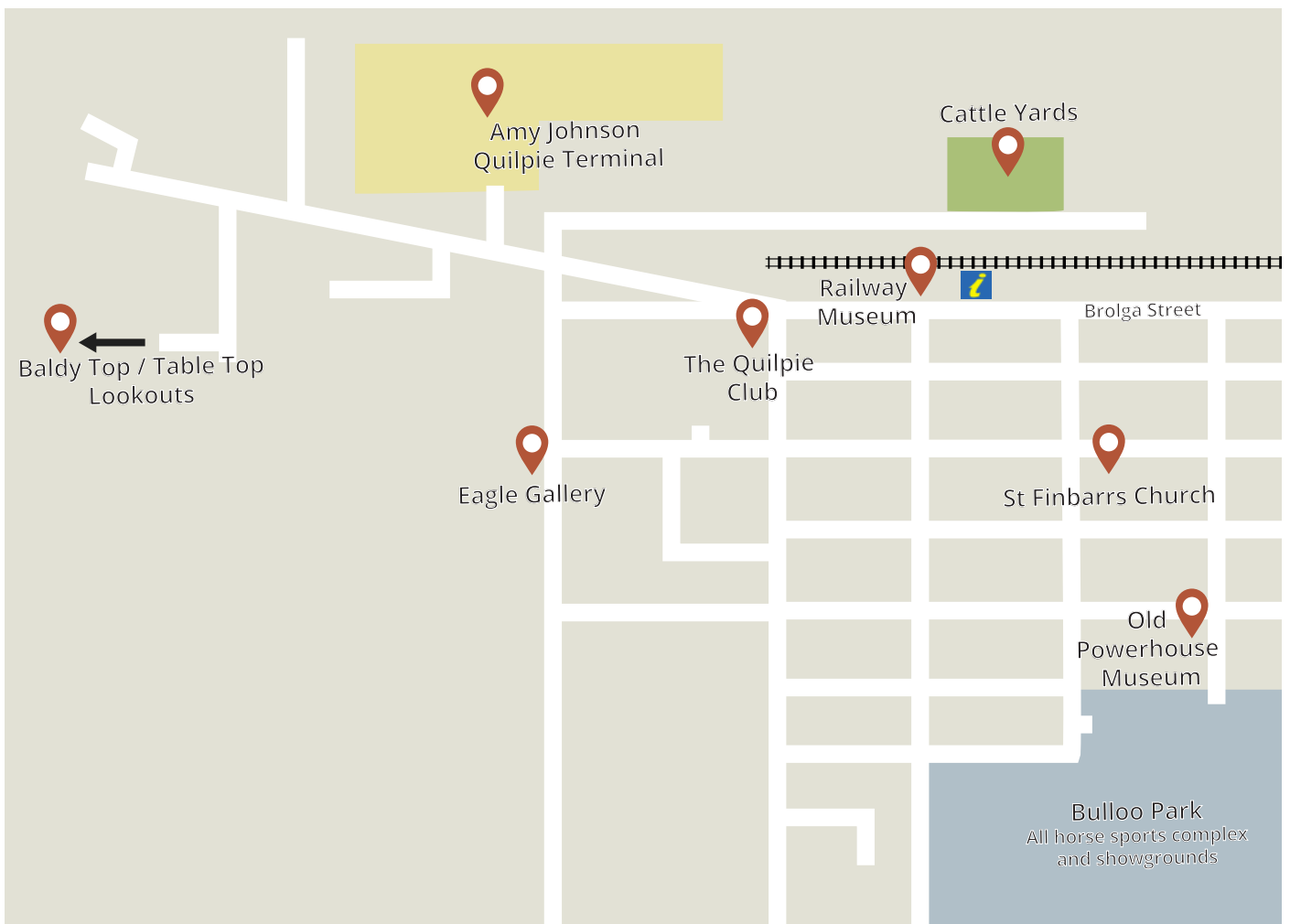
